- ANY return with expenses from self-employment that exceeds \$25,000 or includes home office expense or depreciation or any net losses.
- ANY return with rental income
- ANY return with moving expenses
- ANY return with other income or deductions outside our scope (If uncertain about our scope discuss with preparer or supervisor before beginning the return or waiting in line)

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING WITH YOU WHEN YOU COME:

- COPY OF LAST YEAR'S TAX RETURN(S) AND YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY CARD
- W-2 forms for each employer
- Unemployment compensation statements
- 1095 from the Insurance marketplace (if applicable) or proof of other health insurance
- SSA-1099 form if you were paid Social Security benefits
- All 1099 forms (1099-INT, 1099-DIV, 1099-B, etc.) showing interest and/or dividends and documentation showing original purchase price of sold assets
- 1099-misc. showing any miscellaneous income
- 1099-R from if you received a pension or annuity
- Tabulated total of cash income if self employed
- All forms indicating federal and state income tax paid
- Dependent care provider information (name, plus employer ID or Social Security number)
- Names, dates of birth, and Social Security numbers for all dependents
- Amount of Real Estate Taxes paid in 2017
- Any other tax forms received
- PICTURE ID (both taxpayers if joint return)

As part of their effort to prevent identity theft, the IRS is requiring us to check photo ID for every taxpayer. We strongly recommend that couples filing joint returns attend the tax preparation session together to save the extra trip required to bring in the additional ID with the signed return.
